Union Street Bridge Daily Closures - December 2022

Gowanus Remediation Team (GRT) construction will require intermittent full-day closures of the Union Street Bridge for up to five days a week. **This work began in Spring 2022 and is now expected to last through Spring 2023.** Daily closures in effect from September to June will take place between the hours of 9am to 2pm. Daily closures in effect from July to August will take place between the hours of 7am to 4pm.

The daily closures will be in effect only on days that GRT crews are working in between the bridge abutments. On those days there will be a continuous full-day closure, and signs will be deployed at Bond and Union and Nevins and Union to indicate that the bridge is closed for the day.

The closures will be implemented on certain weekdays intermittently, based on the need to conduct specific construction activities. **For a schedule of planned GRT work at the Union Street Bridge, please visit: <https://gowanussuperfund.com/bridge-information/>**

Please note that at any time all bridges along the Gowanus Canal may experience short term closures lasting about fifteen minutes to facilitate vessel movement. Working along the canal requires frequent vessel movement, resulting in frequent short term bridge closures.
