

# *cleanup of the* **Gowanus Canal**

## **Carroll Street Bridge Update – March 2025**

The NYC Department of Transportation (DOT), the Gowanus Remediation Team (GRT) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) are working collaboratively towards the safe and expeditious reopening of the Carroll Street Bridge.

### **Reopening Timeline**

The design has been finalized. Construction is scheduled to start in April 2025. The repair work is expected to take approximately 9 months to complete, with the reopening of the bridge estimated to be possible in early 2026. This timeline may be subject to change.

### **What Work Will Take Place?**

DOT hired an engineering consultant with expertise in movable bridges to design this repair. GRT will perform the work according to DOT's design. EPA published information about the design, which can be found at [semspub.epa.gov/work/02/746944.pdf](https://semspub.epa.gov/work/02/746944.pdf).
